

2017 Spartan Showcase Rules

1. Have fun and Good Luck!
2. Each team MUST provide a score/clock keeper
3. 3rd-6th grade are 12 minute stopped clock halves
7th and 8th grade are 14 minute stopped clock halves
4. Each team gets three timeouts per game and 1 additional if overtime
5. If a team is up by 30 points in second half it is a running clock until score is lower than a 20 point lead
6. Teams can press until they get up by 25 then please take it off
7. Free throws will be played on the release
8. All players will receive 6 personal fouls
9. All free throws are 1 & 1 unless it is a shooting foul; bonus starts on the 7th foul
(there is no double bonus)
10. Halftime is 3 minutes in length
11. 3rd grade only can move a step up for free throws (please remind ref before game)
12. Overtime will consist of 2 minute stopped, double OT will consist of 1 minute stopped time, third OT is sudden death win by 2 points
13. If there is any disputes the site supervisor will make all final decisions
14. 2 Technical fouls will result in being removed from the bench for the rest of the game
15. If a coach/player/spectator is involved in any fighting and gross unsportsmanlike behavior at all you are disqualified for the rest of the event. Remember score

keepers are neutral parties and can not cheer or say remarks while sitting at the score table.

Spartan Showcase Classic Rules!

16. First team listed or top of bracket is the away team and must wear dark uniform

17. To determine pool seedings we will use the following:

1) head to head 2) plus or minus 15 3) total points scored

18. We are using a 28.5 size ball

19. No games will start before the scheduled time **unless** both coaches agree.

20. We will allow a player to play up a grade for the same club. If a player is on two teams he can play on both teams during pool play only. For bracket play a player may only play on one team. This will alleviate any issues of a player joining another team once his team has been knocked out.

Roster Rules: This is a grade based tournament/All exceptions would need to be approved by tournament director before the event.

- Proof of age and/or grade is required for all players on roster. Acceptable proofs of age are; clean photocopies of birth certificates, adoption papers, or immigration papers.

Proof of grade is a clean copy of any report card of the current school year or school documentation that indicates current grade level. Teams are required to have proof of age and grade on hand at all times.

- If a team is found with ineligible players they may have to forfeit all previous games and possibly be removed from the tournament.

Protest:

- All roster protests must be filed in writing and given to the Tournament Director 45 minutes PRIOR to the protested game accompanied by a \$100.00 protest fee for each player being protested (refundable if protest is upheld). the protest is valid, the

protested team forfeits all previous games. Upon request, teams must provide proof of eligibility.

- Tournament Director has final say on all rulings.
