

Rules and regulations:

1. Teams are guaranteed a minimum of 2 games. This is a double elimination tournament. The tournament is open to any player who will be in the 1st-12th grade as of Fall 2019. We will also have a "post high school" division for adults who have graduated high school. Each team will consist of 3-4 players on their roster.
2. Teams are divided into divisions based on school grade for Fall of 2019. These levels will be 1st/2nd grade, 3rd/4th grade, 5th/6th grade, 7th/8th grade, 9th-12th grade and post high school.
3. A field goal and foul shot are both worth 1 point.
4. A successful goal from behind the take back line is worth 2 points. The player shooting must have both feet completely behind the line when initiating an attempt.
5. Games are played to 15 - win by 2. If a game is not completed within the 20 minute time limit, the team with the most points will be declared the winner.
6. Each game will have a ref, championship game will have 2 refs.
7. Fouls and violations
 - a. All games will be officiated by volunteers. Excessive fouling and rough play will not be tolerated. We reserve the right to eject any player. Any spectator that also has a hard time conducting them self in a good sportsmanship manner will be asked to leave. Foul shots may be awarded.
 - b. Foul shots are awarded after the teams 7th foul.

Waiver: Every player (or parent if player is under the age of 18) must read this waiver. Signatures on the entry form signify that each person has read, understands and abides by this information.
